Who's In the Kitchen? Introducing; Executive Chef Brook T. Lamar

When the Marlin Club opened in 1936, it was because a group of fishermen decided to band together, connected by a shared love of the sport of fishing and respect for the game to provide a welcoming environment to share experiences, stories, and time together. When Executive Chef Brook Lamar joined our team in the summer of 2022, it was for a similar reason. We knew he shared a similar passion: for celebrating and sharing things that he cared about with the local community. For us, it's fishing. For him, it is the ability to procure and prepare cuisine inspired from all around the world, as well as from right here in the harbor.

Working in restaurants since the age of 15-- and managing them since 16-- the former competitive fighter, wrestler, and competition culinary champion is a Western Pennsylvania native who has been opening, growing, expanding, and rehabilitating restaurants all over the country from Atlanta, Charlotte, New Orleans, and Colorado before finally settling in Ocean City for good in 2001.

In each of these places, Lamar has absorbed a bit of each culture, worked with and appreciated local ingredients, mastered regional and cultural preparations and techniques, as well as learned and perfected regional dishes. These experiences and ingredients have informed his palate and expanded his dish repertoire in innumerable ways. Mastering the art of first using what is local, using every part of an ingredient you can, and letting the ingredients shine to produce flavorful, creative, inspired dishes that you will not find just anywhere.

In the Ocean City area for more than 20 years, his resume here on the eastern shore reads like a Who's Who of the Best restaurants on the lower shore: OC Wasabi, Sole Grill, The Globe, The Shark on the Harbor, Fager's Island, Mother's Cantina, and now added to this list is our own Ocean City Marlin Club. To be on this list means that the possibilities for our restaurant are endless. Brought here to elevate and innovate our menu, it's exciting to know that our food will draw people in just as our atmosphere and view already do.
